MAN KILLS ELDERLY, EATS HER FLESH

A 24-year-old man, suspected to be suffering from hydrophobia, allegedly killed an elderly woman and ate her flesh in Rajasthan's Pali district following which police arrested the person and admitted him to a hospital, officials said on Saturday.

Doctors at Bangar Hospital said Surendra Thakur, a resident of Mumbai, "is suffering from hydrophobia" - a fear of water caused by late-stage rabies infection - possibly because he was bitten by a "rabid dog" in the past and did not get the right treatment. According to the police, which quoted eyewitnesses, the incident happened in Saradhana village under Sendra police station on Friday when Shanti Devi (65) had gone to graze her cattle. The accused attacked the woman with a stone and killed her, they said. "The accused is behaving like a mentally sick patient and in an aggressive manner. We have admitted him to the hospital where his medical examination is going on. Even in the hospital, he created a ruckus, after which he was tied up by the nursing staff on a bed," Jaipur Deputy Superintendent of Police Sukhram Bishnoi said. He said the accused had come to Sendra from Mumbai on a bus, which was confirmed through a bus ticket he was carrying.

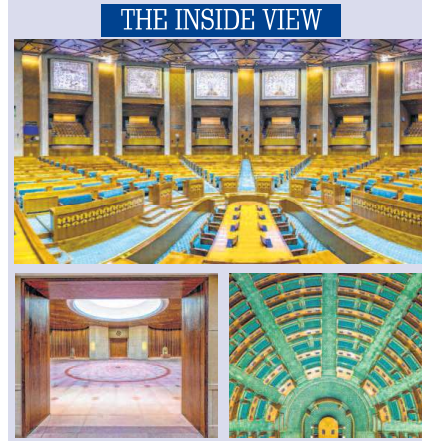
Modi, who had urged people to share a video of the new building on Twitter with the hashtag 'MyParliamentMyPride', also noted that through very emotional voice-overs people are conveying a spirit of pride that the nation is getting a new Parliament building which will keep working to fulfill people's aspirations with more vigour.

Tagging a tweet by Union minister Hardeep Puri lauding the new Parliament building, Modi said on Twitter, "May this Temple of Democracy continue strengthening India's development trajectory and empower millions."

He used the 'MyParliamentMyPride' tag along with his tweet. The prime minister also re-tweeted several people's posts with the video of the new Parliament building and their voiceovers.

In another tweet, Modi said, "Several people are expressing their joy on #MyParliamentMyPride. Through very emotional voice-overs they are conveying a spirit of pride that our nation is getting a new Parliament building which will keep working to fulfill people's aspirations with more vigour." Modi on Friday had said the new Parliament building will make every Indian proud, as he posted a video of the newly-constructed complex on Twitter and urged people to share it on the social media platform with the hashtag 'MyParliamentMyPride'.

AZAD SLAMS OPPOSITION

RAJOURI/JAMMU: DPAP chief Gulam Nabi Azad on Saturday said people are more concerned about problems like inflation and unemployment than whether the new Parliament building will be inaugurated by the President or the prime minister, accusing the opposition of making unnecessary noise over the issue. As many as 19 opposition parties, including the Congress, Left, TMC, SP and AAP have decided to boycott the inauguration, saying sidelining President Droupadi Murmu is not only a "grave insult" but a direct assault on our democracy, which demands a commensurate response.

"I am surprised (over the decision of the opposition) as there are hundreds of issues which are linked to the public. But they do not raise such issues and what they are raising is not connected with people," Azad told PTI here. "People do not have any interest in your personality as they are more concerned about their problems like inflation and unemployment. The opposition does not go for strike or boycott on such issues," he said.

'Saare jahan se achha' poet removed from DU syllabus

Those who laid foundation to break India shouldn't be in syllabus, says VC

NEW DELHI: Those who laid the foundation to break India should not be in the syllabus, Delhi University Vice Chancellor Yogesh Singh said on Friday. The university's academic council in a meeting on Friday had passed a motion for the removal of the chapter titled 'Modern Indian Political Thought'. It is part of the BA sixth-semester paper, officials said.

"Iqbal was the first to raise the idea of partition of India and the establishment of Pakistan. Instead of teaching such people, we should study our national heroes. Those who laid the foundation to break India should not be in the syllabus," the vice chancellor (VC) said, according to a DU statement issued after the nearly 15-hour-long meeting that began 10:30 am on Friday. The university said the VC's proposal was unanimously passed by the academic council.

11 CMs skip...

Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik, who maintains a calculated distance from both the NDA and the Opposition, was also absent from the meeting. "11 Chief Ministers didn't attend the meeting. But several other Chief Ministers did. I have seen similar attendance in previous NITI Aayog Governing Council meetings. They might have their personal reasons," NITI Aayog CEO was quoted saying by news agency ANI. The BJP said the missing Chief Ministers did not bring the voice of the people to a crucial planning meeting, where over a hundred issues were listed to be discussed. NITI Aayog is a significant platform to evolve a shared vision of national development priorities, sectors and strategies with the active involvement of states, it said, adding that it's an important body for determining the entire policy-framework and the road map for the development of the entire country.

"NITI Aayog is very important for the development and planning of the country. It has been invited to this meeting, and the Chief Ministers who have not come are not bringing the voice of the people of their state here. How far will you go to protest against Modi?" BJP leader and former Union Minister Ravi Shankar Prasad said.

Government sources have said boycotting NITI Aayog Governing Council Meetings by Chief Ministers is equal to boycotting the state's development. More than a hundred important issues will be discussed at the Governing Council Meeting (GCM), and states not being represented will lose out, sources said.

"Roadmap to be laid down on following issues: Viksit Bharat@2047, (i) Thrust on SMEs, MSMEs, Infrastructure and Investments, (ii) Minimising Compliances, (iii) Women Empowerment, (iv) Health and Nutrition, (vii) Skill Development, and (viii) Gati Shakti for area development and social infrastructure. People of the states whose CMs boycotted the meeting will not be able to reap the benefits of discussions and decisions on minimising compliances, better infrastructure, incentives, MSMEs, and Skill Development. There is a rich legacy of action taken and citizen welfare from the roadmap laid down by previous GC meetings," they said.

Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Sanjay Raut has said if non-BJP Chief Ministers are boycotting the meeting, it means the Centre is not treating them properly. "Whoever is not obeying the Centre, NITI Aayog is not listening to their demands," he said.

It further explains the projects taken up under PM Modi's leadership across 14 facets of policymaking, ranging from infrastructure to foreign policy to social justice. As per the book, the government under PM Modi's leadership has been steadfast in its commitment to creating equity and opportunity for all citizens. PM Modi has brought the politics of development - Vikasvadi - into the mainstream, making it the focal point around which political discourse and policy action now revolves, the book stated.

Further, it mentioned that since assuming office in 2014, PM Modi has remained firm in his resolve of keeping 'India first' in every policy formulation and action. This resolve is evident in government's handling of both external and internal security, economic management, empowerment schemes for marginalised groups, efforts at cultural conservation and so on," as mentioned in the book.

PM Modi's government has always believed in setting challenging targets and achieving them before the set deadline. This can be seen across sectors whether it is in vaccinating the entire eligible population in record time against Covid-19, recording the nation's highest export in its history in the digital revolution which is taking place across India, achieving monumental targets for rural electrification, in building world-class infrastructure or in providing drinking water facilities across households, it added.

In the last nine years, there has been a paradigm shift in public service delivery and the implementation of government schemes under the JAM Trinity-Jan Dhan, Aadhar, and Mobile, the book said. "JAM Trinity is the key enabler of India's transformed and well-developed digital landscape. It has removed intermediaries and permits the direct transfer of benefits into an intended beneficiary's bank account. For a country to prosper, it has to be in the digital revolution which grows rapidly and the government under PM Modi's dynamic leadership understands this", it stated.

The book further stated that the completion of infrastructure projects that were delayed over decades, as well as starting and completing new ones has been the cornerstone of this government's developmental approach.

Adding to the achievements of the PM Modi-led government, the United Nations declared June 21st as International Yoga Day, an acknowledgement of the global recognition of Indian heritage.

According to sources, it was feared that the members of the terrorist outfit were keeping an eye on the ATS, but before they could escape, the officers took them into their custody.
